MODERN SLAVERY SURVEY -Bishop Patrick Lynch writes: *"In 2016, Pope Francis called Modern Slavery a 'true crime against humanity' and urged the Catholic Church to assist in the fight to eliminate it. The eradication of Modern Slavery was included in the United Nations Sustainable Development goals in 2015. As a Church we are in a privileged position as many of those exploited look to the church and come to the Church for help. In this survey we are*

asking you to help us identify these vulnerable communities – who they are, where they are, what they need, and what you need to support them effectively. This survey will assist us, via the Santa Marta Group, in gathering important data in the fight against Modern Slavery. It is being conducted in collaboration with the Centre for the Study of Modern Slavery at St Mary's University. We appreciate your time in completing this short survey."
